

# What is FSSE Junior Gathering?

Junior Gathering is a brilliant week in which young people have a chance to make new friends and be together in a Quaker environment. The theme for this year, chosen by the young people, is "Caring for ourselves and others". The event will take place at Leighton Park School in Reading.

This year will be a little different than usual, but the things that make the event so special will still be there. In speaker sessions, we will explore ideas through workshops, drama, worship, films and games. The week spent with friends who share Quaker values can be life-changing and is also hugely good fun. A variety of activities to choose from include craft, cooking, music, discussions and sports. And then we have base groups, quizzes, wide games, entertainments and a themed disco.

We welcome both regular attenders and young people who do not usually come to Quaker Meeting.

Everyone will be in a base group made up of about eight young people as well as two adult volunteers. The base group is your Junior Gathering family, and everyone looks after each other. Everyone has their own bedroom, some shared and some single; when they are shared it will be with those of a similar age. Everyone also has a "secret friend" who secretly does kind things and gives you tiny presents – it might be worth bringing a couple of tiny gifts for your secret friend.

We follow Britain Yearly Meeting guidelines concerning the safety and wellbeing of those taking part. Our Child Protection Policy is on the <u>FSSE website</u>. All adult volunteers are required to have current, enhanced checks from the Disclosure and Barring Service.

This year, we have looked carefully at how to keep the essence of Junior Gathering, while still minimising the risk of coronavirus to us and others. As such, our current policy is that we will require all participants to take a lateral flow test before starting the event, and we will need to see that the result is negative. We anticipate staff having been vaccinated, but we will all also be taking tests before the event starts. Any visitors to the event will need to do the same. The Oxford trip won't happen this year – we know this will be missed, it's one of the highlights of the week, but it's just not feasible this year.

With a few months to go, we expect the law and guidance will continue to change. The event coordinators and trustees will regularly review this to ensure we keep the right balance of a fun, friendly, safe event.

## **Applications**

At the end of June 'joining instructions' with full information of what to bring, and the JG Boundaries will be sent to everyone. The young people will also be invited to send in requests for room-share.

## Payment & Bursaries

Full payment of £380 is due 30th June. No-one will be prevented from attending Junior Gathering by difficulty with payment. Most Local and Area Meetings will help with payment, but if you need a grant in addition, please let the bookings secretary know. You can send a cheque or make a BACS transfer, please email the bookings secretary for details. If the event cannot go ahead, payments will be refunded in full.

#### Travel

**Car**: The main entrance to the school is on Shinfield Road, postcode: RG2 7ED. Please do not arrive before 4pm on Saturday 14th August because we will not be ready for you! Pick up is at 10am on Saturday 21st August.

**Coach**: Due to COVID-19, we encourage people to come to Junior Gathering by private transport or car-sharing. Depending on numbers we may be able to arrange a coach to and from Friends' House, Euston – please indicate when booking if you would use this option.

#### Costs

Junior Gathering fee: £380

Optional: Coach from Friends House to Leighton Park School and return: £TBC – was £20 in 2019.

Pocket money for tuck shop (about £20 recommended)

#### Meals

All dietary requirements can be catered for and there is always a choice of food so no-one has to eat what they don't like. Please make sure to include any dietary needs on the application form (e.g. vegetarian, vegan, food allergies ...)

#### Insurance

Any items of value brought to Junior Gathering must be fully insured against loss and damage. Junior Gathering cannot be responsible for personal property.

## Packing ideas

- Change of clothes
- Nightwear
- Underwear
- Washing things
- Indoor and outdoor shoes
- Waterproof coat

- **Mobile phones** may be brought with you, but they will only be available during free time

Smoking and alcohol are not allowed at Junior Gathering. If any young person is found in possession of cigarettes, tobacco in any form, alcoholic drinks or recreational drugs, this could result in the young person being sent home immediately.
